The two red phone boxes at Church Hill and The Pound have been adopted by the Town Council and returned to their former scarlet glory. A group of volunteers have been thinking about their future uses and it has been decided that the Church Hill box will be a centre for rotating displays, to allow local (non-commercial) community groups to 'rent' it for a period of time to organise their own displays. The box at The Pound will be used for static displays (i.e. Tourist information leaflets, local 'finds' etc.), swap shop for toys and occasional 'pop-up events e.g. plant sales/ cake sales etc.

TAKE A RING SIDE SEAT


As part of a rolling programme of refurbishment of the benches in Stalbridge in public spaces the bench on The Ring is currently being refurbished and will be re-instated in due course.
