

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LOWER ROAD, STALBRIDGE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Lower Road, Stalbridge from the junction with Springfields, Stalbridge to a point approximately 160 metres to the east. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 6th January 2020 and remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20th March 2020.

This Order will enable CJL Construction Ltd safe access to install mains services, remove existing vegetation, construction of a new footpath including kerbs, signs and street lighting as well as resurfacing the highway in relation to the Section 278 agreement for the new development.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is indicated by the blue line on the map below.
