Whilst it was understood that the application is not a planning application but a request for Dorset Council to determine whether or not Prior Approval is required for the proposal, it was

felt that members comments regarding the construction process and highways and pedestrian safety should be submitted.

<u>RESOLVED</u>: The local knowledge suggests that 20/30 HGV's per day use the junction of Station Rd and the A357 where the site is located. Members have concerns as to how the construction site will be managed in terms of delivery and removal vehicles which will cause an obstruction at this junction and cause a safety issue in terms of vehicles and pedestrians.
