



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BARROW HILL, STALBRIDGE

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along BARROW HILL, STALBRIDGE from a point 20 metres west of its junction with Park Grove to a point adjacent to the public right of way (Public Footpath 4, Stalbridge), between No. 7, Park Road and No. 8, Barrow Lea, a distance of approximately 200 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on Monday 16 October 2017 and will remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by Friday 24 November 2017

This order will enable Wessex Water safe access to replace their water main in the highway.

An alternative vehicular route will be signed to the south (Stourton Caundle / Warbridge).
