

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A357, STALBRIDGE ROAD, STALBRIDGE

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the A357, STALBRIDGE ROAD, STALBRIDGE between Drew's Lane and Landshire Lane, a distance of approximately 900 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on Monday 05 December 2016 and will remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by Friday 16 December 2016. The works will take place between 09.00hrs and 16.00hrs on weekdays only - the road will be open outside of these times and also over the weekend.

This order will enable Dorset County Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
