a. P/VOC/2021/00059 & P/VOL/2021/00210 Erect two storey rear extension and single storey garden room. (Variation of Condition No. 2 of Planning Permission No. 2/2020/1033/HOUSE to amend the fenestration details) . 5 Anglesey cottages, Ring Street, Stalbridge DT10 2NE. Mr M Eastgate.

It was understood that the amended plans for the garden room reduced the window sizes on east and north elevations and added limestone render and bradstone coynes.

 b. P/FUL/2020/00406 Change of use of agricultural land to form a tennis court with fence enclosure. Corner Farm Stalbridge Weston Village Road Stalbridge Weston Dorset DT10 2LA Mr & Mrs D Barbour.

There was some question with regard to the relationship of the proposed tennis court to the residential curtilage of Corner farm and it was noted that the court would not be visible form the road.

<u>RESOLVED</u>: Proposed and unanimously agreed to support the application on the condition that the tennis court is for the private use of Corner Farm only
