### **NDDC legacy funding**

With the impending unitarization of Dorset Councils there was a one-off opportunity to leave a lasting legacy in North Dorset from capital reserves which came from the sale of North Dorset District Council assets.

Community projects within North Dorset towns principal villages which would benefit from funding for capital projects were identified by North Dorset Cabinet members working with Officers of the Council and the portfolio holder for Economy & Regeneration.

Stalbridge Town Councils aspiration to extend the Hub building to provide a heritage centre and possibly provide treatment rooms to the NHS was identified by North Dorset District Council as one of these capital projects and the grant of the legacy funding of £70,000 was made based on the terms of this project.

**TCM 09.01.19: North Dorset District Councillors report** : The Shadow Council have been very active in setting the future budget for the new council and that capital grants of £70,000 legacy funding from NDDC have been made to The Trailway and Stalbridge Town Council for the aspiration project to provide a heritage centre and consulting rooms by extending The Hub.

**TCM 27.03.19** : The Clerk advised that the NDDC legacy funding £70,000 had been received.
