### STATION ROAD NORTH PLANNING APPLICATION

The Town Council are in the process of engaging with planning consultants to respond to an outline application

to erect up to 160 No. dwellings on the north of Lower Road. The decision not to support the application was made based on the cumulative negative effect on traffic & highways safety, lack of sustainability, detriment to the Conservation Area, poor pedestrian & cycle connectivity, unsuitable location, loss of rural character and potential flooding.

### STALBRIDGE YOUTH CLUB UPDATE

Its' looking highly likely that the youth club in Stalbridge will re-open in September on Wednesdays 6:00pm-8:00pm run by 'Youth Connect South West'. To assist them we have a capable band of willing local volunteers to whom we are very grateful.

### **TOWN FUTURE VISION (FTV)PROJECT**

In 2006, a process was started to identify; how the community viewed itself at the time, how it wanted to develop and, what it needed to do to make it happen. Known as the *Town Plan* it was finished in 2008 and covered many aspects, including community life, the local economy and the environment.

In 2014 another document titled **Shaping Stalbridge** was produced, picking up some of the remaining actions from the 2008 Town Plan.

The Town Council has commenced the *FTV* project to ensure the management of the Town is fit for purpose in a growing future community. A working party have been looking at the elements contained within the proposed "Portfolio Structure". Each portfolio will have a specific and individual relationship to the towns existing needs and future developments and will contain a mix of; legal, democratic and town affairs. The next stage will be to detail the roles Councillors will be expected to contribute within the new portfolio structure and the Terms of Reference for how these new portfolio groups will operate going forward.
