#### **PRECEPT 23/24**

The Precept is Stalbridge Town Council's share of your Council Tax. This part of the Council Tax is to maintain local services that the Town Council are responsible for: maintaining and delivering open spaces and play facilities in

our parks, street cleaning, waste & dog bins, public WC facility, street furniture and grit bins. At the January meeting the Town Councils precept was resolved at £135,500 which equates to a decrease of £2.73 per annum on a Band D Equivalent Charge for the Town Council's part of the council tax.

In 2023/24 the following grants will be made:

Playing Fields Trust £2,500 (maintenance of the playing fields sports facility)

St Marys PCC £6,300 (Churchyard maintenance)

Stalbridge Hall £3,600 (CCTV system)
