Members had submitted suggestions prior to the meeting. Those who had made suggestions explained the reasons behind them.

# 8. Proposal for installation of a milk vending machine at the Hub, Station Rd, Stalbridge K Garland

A presentation was received Dan and Alex from The Dorset Dairy Co. It was noted that there would be a structure or a similar design to a shepherds hut and that there may be an opportunity for posting community notices. It was noted that the unit would be fully managed, ensured by the owners and there would be an income to the TC of £100.

<u>RESOLVED</u>: To enter into an agreement with The Dorset Dairy Co to install of a milk vending machine at The Hub, Station Rd, Stalbridge subject to a contractual agreement.

# 9. Proposal that the Town Council to provide a notice board on the west side of Ring Street adjacent to Grace Haine.

A letter from J Wardell which was read out. B Lovell advised that the proposal had arisen in reaction to complaints that people do not know what is going on at Town Council and in his opinion the current notice board at the top of Station Rd is not on a walking route. It was noted that informal permission had been given by Dikes & DC for a free standing board. There were varying opinions on whether a new board would be used and if the location was suitable. Further to this members had different ideas on the size and materials of the board. It was noted that the proposal did not include the removal of the existing board.

<u>RESOLVED:</u> To provide a Town Council notice board on the west side of Ring Street adjacent to Grace Haine, funding to be allocated from the 20.21 precept.
