



EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TRIANGLE FARM LANE, STALBRIDGE

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Triangle Farm Lane, Stalbridge a distance of approximately 435 metres. The notice is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 1st August 2016 and remain in force for 21 days. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12th August 2016.

This notice will enable Dorset County Council on behalf of Wessex Water to carry out repairs to a collapsed water pipe which is causing the carriageway to subside.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
